FAMILY DISCUSSION . . .

Pray before you begin.

DEBRIEF

Ask each other what you've been learning so far throughout this month of being ROOTED.

DIG

Read Psalm 37:4&5, Proverbs 16:3, 2 Corinthians 9:6-15

DECLARE

What do you hear God saying through these verses?
What is the good news?

DISCUSS

What things does God want us to do as a family? Or what is do you think God is calling you to do individually? Is God calling you/us to prune an area of your life in order to flourish. Write down some ideas;

DISCERN

Ask God to provide as you step out in faith and commit to being a part of the ROOTED campaign for the next 36 months. Pray that God would guide our church in this season and for the people whose lives will be changed through the people and ministries of One Life. Pray for the city of Concord.

DO

Decide how you will give and write it down on your family's commitment card. Bring it to church on **February 25**.

One Life Church Family,

We hope that this discussion guide will help you decide how to be a part of our ROOTED capital campaign.

Use this guide to talk and pray with your family, a close friend, or your life group about the commitment you plan to make on commitment Sunday (February 25).

Before you talk

Pick a time where you can get together before commitment Sunday. If you are single, schedule a time with a trusted friend or two to discuss your commitment. If you live with your family, schedule a time where the entire family can come together and talk about your commitment. As you meet with friends and family, ask for their input including questions and suggestions.

Block off 30 minutes to an hour and minimize distractions that could come up. We know your kids might be considered a "distraction." However, this is a really cool time to involve them in what God is doing.

If you're leading the discussion with your family, review the discussion guide ahead of time and be ready to challenge each family member to think of sacrifices they can make in order to help your family become more rooted.

Make Your Commitment

Bring your completed commitment card with you to One Life on February 25. Then make sure to be at church on March 11, when we'll announce the total for the ROOTED campaign. It's going to be an awesome celebration Sunday!
